



How to use the plugin "Password Changing" v2020.1

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1. Before to start

This plugin can improve your project to offer to you new features not provided by Website X5 software.

Unzip the files into a personal directory under the root of your website. By example uncompress files into **afs-demo/pwd** directory

After decompression you will get following files:

afs_pwdchanging.php	--> the plugin PHP file name is here
afs_dbconnect.php	--> file to configure your database parameters
afs_config.php	--> file to configure the logo, URL ... etc
afs_style.css	--> CSS file for look & feel

If the plugin has some messages inside, the following files are present too:

afs_messages.php	--> default messages file for the plugin
afs_messages fr.php	--> french messages for the plugin
afs_messages us.php	--> english messages for the plugin

Do not change the name files. The plugin needs these names

2. Configure your database parameters (if necessary):

You need to edit **afs_dbconnect.php** file to configure your database parameters and if necessary table name to used with the plugin

3. Configuration with crypted passwords or not:

You need to edit **afs_config.php** file to configure if your database uses crypted passwords or not. Crypted passwords are supported since the Website X5 Pro v2020.1 Preview (January 2020)



4. Configure your language (if necessary):

Two default language files (**afs_messages fr.php** & **afs_messages us.php**) are provided by default. The english language is used by default by the plugin.

To create you personal messages with your language you need to copy one of example and to edit the variables with your language.

When done, you **can copy & replace** these variables into the **afs_messages.php** file which is the used file by default.

5. Configure the visual with your preference

You can change many parameters into the plugin like:

Logo
URL to redirect
Color
Border
Background
...etc..

The default parameters are into the **afs_config.php** file for the **logo** and into **afs_style.css** for the **look & feel**. You can change any values into this file by yours.

6. How to test it without Website X5

Before to configure the plugin with Website X5 we recommend tes test it alone. So to do that You need to unzip the file into a specific directory on your website.

Configure **dbconnect.php** file and **afs_config.php** files before to start the plugin.

When you configuration is done you can have a direct access to the plugin byt your browser with the following command:

https://www.yourwebsite.com/plugin_directory/pwdchanging.php

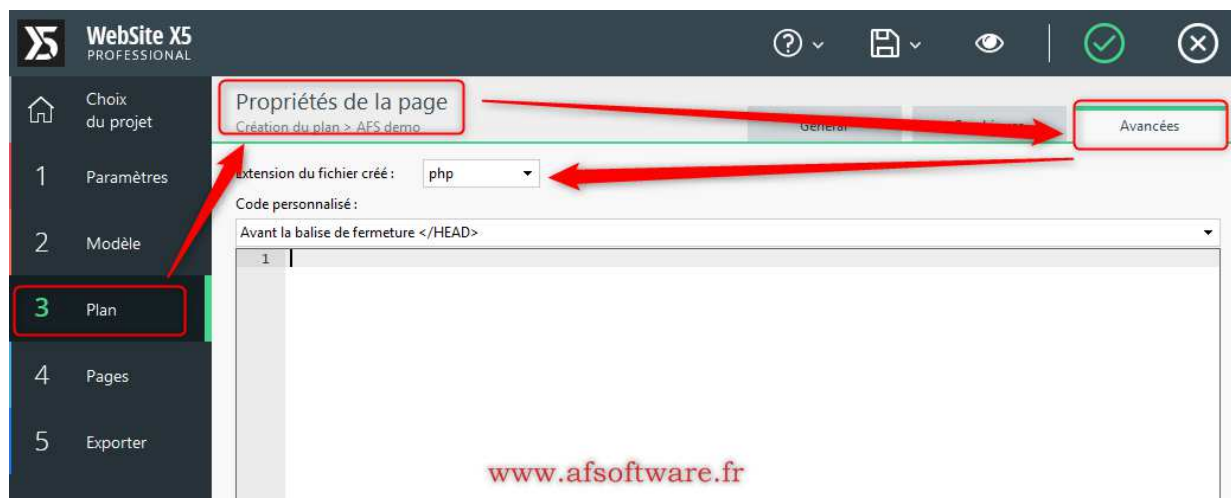

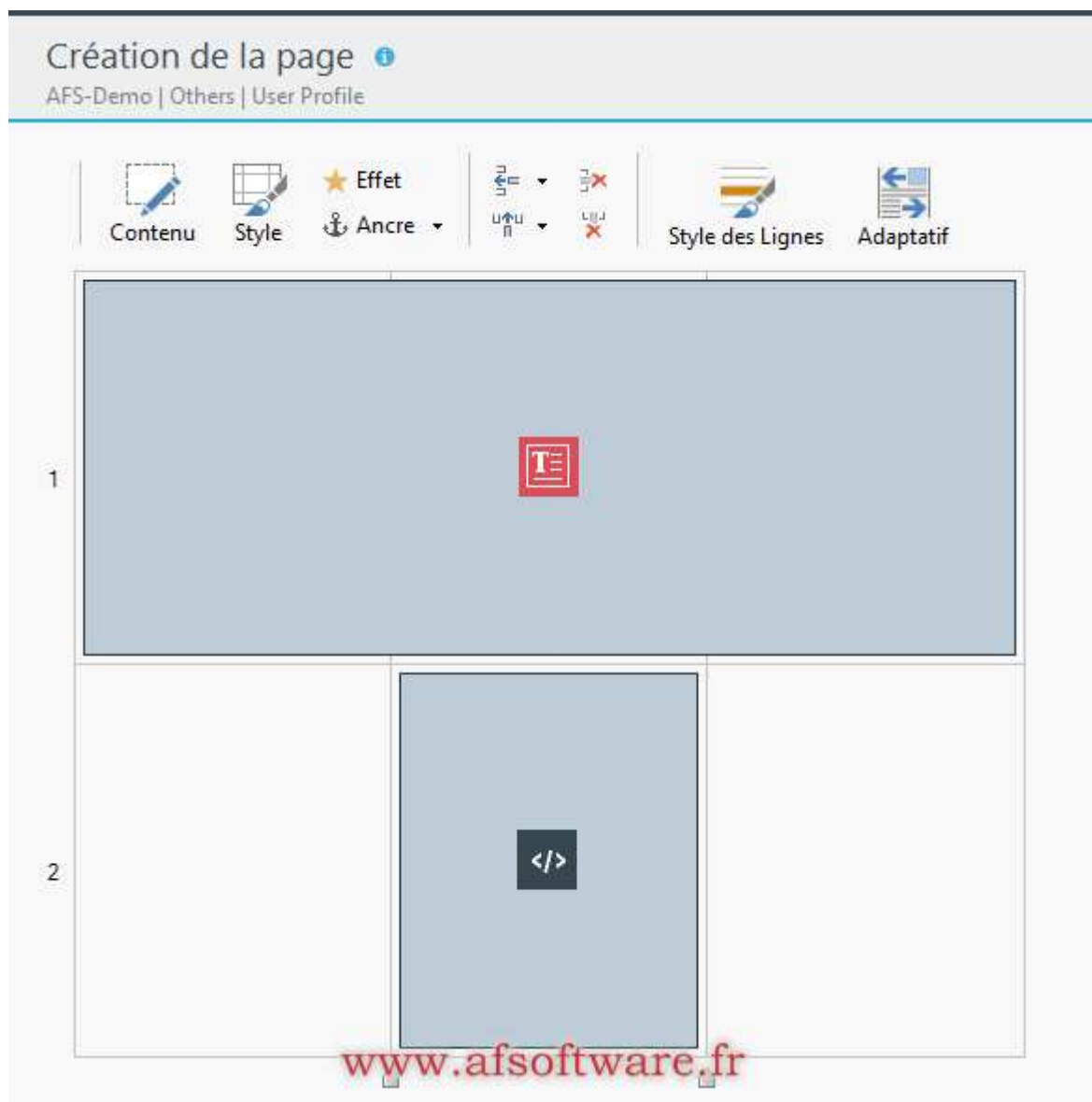

Into your page you need to add an HTML object like below.



Open the HTML object and add just the following code.

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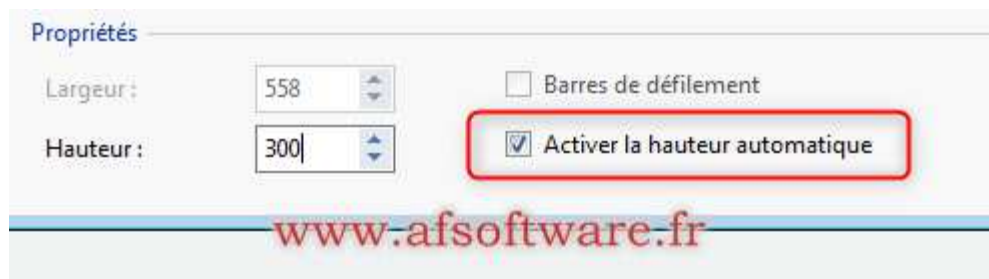

and the display into HTML object is:

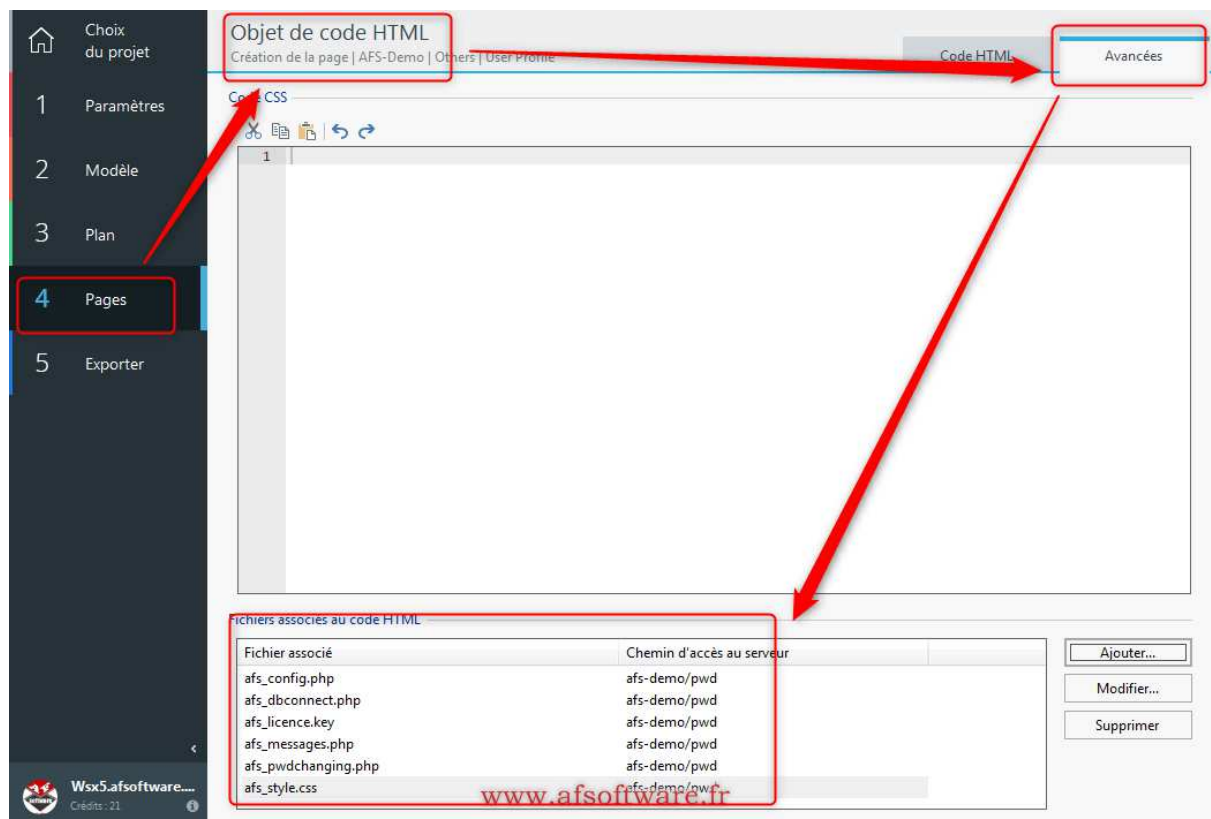


We recommend to fix the height to 750 of your html object and to deactivate the vertical bar. But the automatic settings are OK too.



Your object is almost ready.

To be sure **to export all necessary plugin files during a website downloading**, you need to add the used files into the **Advanced tab** of the HTML Object like below:



You **need to export** your project to the website **to test it**. The **WSX5 internal viewer** or via an **external browser does not works**, because the page is coded with PHP extension. And extension PHP file needs to be execute on the server side.

It's not a restriction of the plugin, it's a main functionality of PHP !

After your export, you can check where is exported your website if the root directory has the choosen directory (here afs-demo/pwd) ready with the associated files.

When the plugin is running you will have the following displayed **on your screen**.

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8. To force the transfer again of modified files after first transfer

If you change any parameters into any files from the installation directory (here afs-demo/pwd) it's **IMPORTANT to reactivate files transfer** into your project.

To force again the files to be transferred you need to **open your** HTML objet and to click on 'Advanced' tab

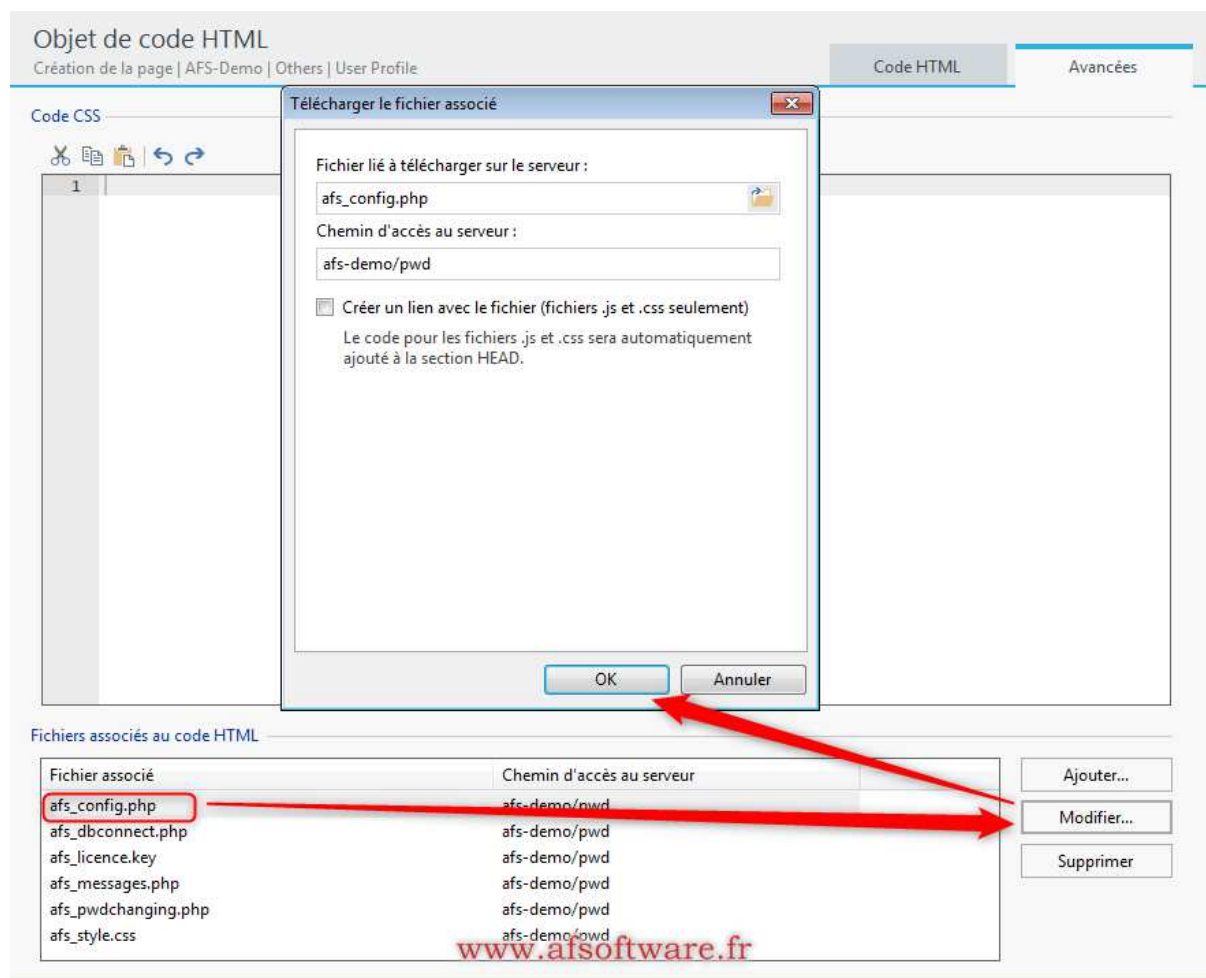
